Pear, Callery *Pyrus calleryana*

- Medium-sized deciduous tree
- Tear-drop shaped in youth and spreading out with age
- 30' to 40' tall and about onethird as wide
- Fast growth rate
- Leaves are held on long stems
- 2" to 3" long, almost as wide
- Glossy, dark green leaf color
- Autumn reds, purples, and oranges; Very attractive
- Laves tend to hold late, freezes could happen before color fully develops
- White attractive flowers
- Usually flowers peak before leaf set
- Flowers late April to early May
- Round pears; only about 0.5"
- Fruit is covered in russet dots
- Olive-brown to tan color
- Bark is light brown to gray
- Limb breakage from wind, snow and ice
