TrailMaster Report:

Carol MacInnes and Marcia Bryan approached 3 of the 7 landowners along the potential Auburn Trail. One said maybe, one is enthusiastic, and one uses the hill toward the trail area for target practice. This landowner is willing to work with us however, so we may be able to route the trail lower to avoid the target practice area. Larry Fisher thought maybe the power lines paralleled this area so he will call RG&E to see if walking under the powerlines is an option for places where we run into landowner difficulties.

TrailBoss Report:

Larry Fisher talked to a landowner who turned out to be a civil engineer. He may be a possibility for designing a bridge for us over Irondequoit Creek. Dave Wright looked through Boughton Park for the steel beams which the Boughton Park Commission offered, but couldn't find them. Larry offered to take pictures of the Auburn trail area where we need the bridge and the beams we have available to show the engineer.

Misc .:

Marcia Bryan reported that for last month's hike, 10 people walked the potential Indian Trail through the ambush area.

Dave Wright offered that he has a good source for printed sweatshirts and T shirts if we need it in the future.

Grant Money:

Marcia sent a letter to Ontario Pathways to let them know that we wish to work with them to apply for grant money. She sent them a map of the sections of the Auburn trail we have already developed. Carol MacInnes noted that we need to begin thinking about how we will itemize the dollars needed for the grant and how we'll raise our 20% portion. In addition to building the bridge we may need money to buy 2,000 ft. of land from Penn Central.
