Trail Master by Carol MacInnes

Colyer subdivision on County Road 9- Carol has been trying to contact Rudy Kumpf, the landowner between the Colyer subdivision and the 100 Acre Woods Trail that is on town property. Brian Emelson is meeting with Brian Reh on 11/21 at 8 AM at Brian's office to review where the trail can go. This subject is on the Planning Board agenda for Nov. 28. Dave W. will attend.

Trail Boss by Larry Fisher (absent)

Will try to mow the Royal View Trail under the power lines and cut a new entrance into the woods if the weather permits. Planning to winterize the equipment soon.

Bridge over Great Brook on Apple Farm property- DEC needs topo maps of all the bridges we have planned to build. Chauncy will print the Google maps from our website.

Domine property- Because of the size and cost of this bridge, we feel we should have a permanent (or at least long term) easement for the trail and bridge. We are waiting for Domine to OK the revocable permit. Chauncy is checking on the possibility of a concrete bridge. This would be a good test site. Brian mentioned that he is expecting another multi-use grant in 2007 and that there are still some funds left from a 2005 grant.

The bridge over White Brook on Helen Schrader's property needs to be replaced. Chauncy has a design, and a rough cost. Mrs. Schrader said she would pay for half of the materials. VHT will pay for the remainder of the cost (~\$700).

Last Hike

Seven hikers and two dogs enjoyed the hike at Boughton Park. Hiked almost every inch of trail in the park. Started to sprinkle just as we were finishing.

Old Business

Anyone who needs a special Victor Hiking license plate holder, please contact Dave Wright. They are only \$5. Show your support for Victor Trails. Brian asked for eight for the 4 parks & rec. vehicles. Dave W. will deliver them and give them an invoice.

SAFTEA-LU Transportation Enhancement Program (TEP)- We got the grant!!!!! Federal reimbursement of up to \$619,500 on the \$885,000 project. A selection committee will interview acceptable engineering firms. Actual construction may not start until 2008.

Genesee Region Trails Coalition - Motion was made by Dave C. and seconded by Chauncy to authorize Dave W. to sign and return the letter of agreement. We will need to give GRTC a six month update on or before April 29, 2007. Brian will contact Fisher Associates to get a sketch of the bridge re-decking and hand rails. Recommended width is 8 feet. The Lehigh Trail will then be able to continue east to Lehigh Crossing Park.

Walkable Community Committee: Next meeting is Nov. 21. Working on code changes.

Black Diamond Dualthon- Saturday, October 21 at Fishers Park. 145 participants. Over 50 volunteers. Seasonal weather. Great event. They ended up with a small profit which will be used for trail improvements.

Charlie's Old Goat Trail Run 65 participants. All completed the course. Lots of volunteers, food and sponsors.

Hunting Season- As in past years, be aware of big game hunting season. Wear blaze orange, don't hike alone, make noise or don't hike until Jan. 1. Shotgun starts Saturday, Nov. 18.

Trails Central- Jeff has completed his work. Trying to transfer it to www.trailsnewyork.org.

Auburn Trails Project- Still waiting for two landowners to sign off on the ROW. Brian meeting with them next week.

Goals and budget for 2007- Chauncy made a brief presentation to the Victor Town Board on Oct. 23. We are looking to spend about \$10,000 on foot bridges, some of which are on town property.
