Discussion of bandanas with VHT logo on one corner and EVT on another corner for a cost of \$1, which will cover a portion of the cost. Extras can be handed out at the volunteer appreciation dinner
- VHT received an email about a proposed new house on the corner of Probst and Miles Cutting Roads.
 Building will require planning board approval. The person that wrote the email does not want a house built on the property.
- The bees on the Dominie Trail Bridge stung more hikers so Chauncy and Carole Fisher vacuumed the bridge to remediate the nest. Wasps were on the Seneca Trail near Boughton Park during work party day..

- Chauncy passed out updated photos of the area proposed for observations decks in LeHigh Crossing Park
